

Grading Scale

Participation 45%

Students must take an active part in learning daily. This includes practicing outside of the school day in order to participate with required material in class.

Playing Quizzes/ Written Tests 45%

Playing Quiz: Students will be assessed using, but not limited to; rubrics, recordings, and by way of computer software (Smartmusic).

All performances are graded as a playing quiz!

Attendance at performances will count as a portion of the quiz grade. If you are not able to attend a performance, you must inform Mr. Haas in writing at least two weeks prior to the performance and schedule a time to take the quiz prior to the performance. If you are absent from a performance due to an emergency, documentation, in line with district policy, must be provided in order to make up the grade with full credit.

Written Test: Students will demonstrate their knowledge of their instrument, music notation, theory, and history.

Homework 10%

Students will practice material based on their individual needs and the needs of the band. Assignments will be given via Google Classroom.

The band will rehearse as soon as possible. It is recommended that each student have their instrument and required supplies by the start of the second week of school (9/3/2019).

While we do have facilities for rehearsal, it is <u>highly recommended</u> that each student bring his/her instrument home each night. We cannot guarantee that any instrument will be 100% secure. This also helps in fostering good practice habits.

There are computer programs available that will benefit members of the band. These programs have a minimal cost and can be downloaded directly from the Internet.

These programs are not required; however, they can make practicing more entertaining and help to motivate the students.

<u>Noteflight</u> is an online music notation program that allows students to compose music on a computer and have it played back to them. Noteflight is web based. https://www.noteflight.com/login

Finale Notepad This is a music notation program that allows students to compose music on a computer and have it played back to them. Students are able to save and print their work. Finale Notepad is a program that you must download and install on your computer. For more information please go to:

Smartmusic

The new SmartMusic is in the cloud. This means it supports the devices students use today, including Chromebooks, iPads, and computers. What's more, students can connect from different locations and devices using one account. There is no longer an excuse for not practicing – because they can do it anywhere.

Now your students can choose to:

- Hear their part played by their instrument rather than a piano.
- See a count-off for multi-measure rests.
- Hear more or less of the accompaniment, their part, or the metronome.
- Control whether the measure being played is highlighted, whether or not to view the cursor, and if the cursor flows or moves beat-by-beat.
- Windows and Mac

- Chromebook
 - Latest version of Chrome OS required

- iPad requirements
 - SmartMusic requires a dedicated app for iPads. You can download the app at the Apple app store.
 - O A7 processor models and later iPad Air, iPad Air 2, iPad mini 2, iPad mini 3, iPad mini 4, 12.9-inch iPad Pro, or 9.7-inch iPad Pro
 - o iOS 9.0 or later required
 - Headphones recommended
